- Officials are remunerated for their time and most work is weekend-based.

Inviting the top 10 & under Boy and Girl players in our District, our CTC provides superior training at a lower cost and offers these players an opportunity to hit with each other; creating camaraderie, friendships and future hitting partners. Offered during the indoor tennis season, our CTC features 18 hours of instruction and training. The coaches also talk to our young players about important tennis topics such as hydration, athletic enhancement (improved hand-eye coordination), navigating the ranking system, and the do's and don'ts of tournament play. The CTC's goal is to offer a great vehicle for training with the green-dot ball, while ensuring good tennis habits to last a lifetime!

Our Southeastern Michigan players had a great experience in the 2013-14 season. The CTC sessions allowed them to have an additional training opportunity outside of a tournament setting. # In Memory of...

# JON FISCHER

1947-2014

Jon was always a "Meeechigan man", having graduated from the University of Michigan with a Political Science degree. During his college days, he found his way into the tennis teaching profession by teaching lessons in the community



education department in Huntington Woods. When Huron Valley Tennis Club opened in 1970, Jon quickly became Head Pro and stayed for 14 years before becoming Director of Junior Tennis at Franklin Athletic Club in 1984. In 1990, he became Head Pro at Travis Pointe Country Club, where he remained involved.

Although Jon taught individuals of all ages, much of his work had been with juniors. He always brought a little something personal to the court for each – a nickname or a joke to make a child feel special.

**Jon's coaching produced several All**-Americans, and more than a few of those became USPTA teaching professionals or coaches. Jon also developed six National Champions early in his career - a superb accomplishment!

Jon's influence on tennis, especially within our District, has been impactful.

Jon was very involved in the USTA since the early 1970's, serving as Chair of the Southeast Michigan District Ranking Committee and the Tournament Regulations Committee. Jon was Area Training Center head coach/administrator in its inaugural year (1990), chaired the District Qualifier Committee in the mid-1990's and became President of the District in 1993. Jon was also active in the Detroit Patrons Tennis Association, a charitable organization established to help youth programs in Southeast Michigan.

At the Midwest Section level, Jon was an active volunteer in the 1990's for nearly 10 years, as coach of a Zonal 12's Team and member of the Player Development Committee. He later served as Chair of the Section Bylaws Committee (2000-1) and was a member of the Junior Competition Coaches Commission (2012-3). Jon served as Tournament Director of the Girls 16s National Indoor for many years.

In 1994, the Southeast Michigan District presented Jon with the William F. Beyer Award, the District's most prestigious award given to an individual who contributed unselfishly and immeasurably to the game of tennis.

Most recently, Jon served on the Southeast Michigan District's Junior Competition Committee and was interested in developing an adaptive tennis program in the Ann Arbor Area. Although he suffered from diabetes for many years, he continued to give his time to what he loved most — TENNIS!
