





WHAT IS TEAM CHALLENGE?



A Team Challenge is a new program designed as an introduction to competition for players ages 5-18, that focuses on teamwork, character development, and challenging players' skills. The program can be delivered either as a single event or as a series of events (league-play) with the goal of offering a competitive play experience in a fun and social environment. The Team Challenge has three basic components that are essential in offering a kid-friendly tennis event:



An Experience allowing players to compete on similar levels whether in red, orange or green stages of development


WHO IS TEAM CHALLENGE FOR?

Local Pro Continues Win Streak

Mike Rose, tennis pro at Country Club of Detroit in Grosse Pointe Farms, extended his win streak to 19-0 on the men's 60 singles tennis circuit with a win in Toronto on Canada Day. Rose, the #2 seed, defeated #4 seed David Anderson of Halifax 6-2, 6-0 to claim the International Tennis Federation Toronto Senior Championship title. The day before, Anderson defeated the #1 seed, Barry Goman, who is ranked #68 in the world.

After dropping the first set in his new age division in January, Rose has won 34 straight sets. This victory came on the heels of back-to-back clay court Category 2 championships in Indianapolis, IN and Wheeling, WV. He has climbed from #439 to #25 in the nation in the past two months.

On July 13, 2018, Ted departed this world unexpectedly while doing his favorite thing, playing a tennis match with his mixed doubles team at the Beverly Hills Athletic Club. According to his obituary, Ted was a man of many talents: life coach, successful author, speaker and facilitator. He had an uncanny ability to reach people in deep and positive ways.

Ted genuinely enjoyed life and lived it to the fullest. He loved people, traveling, tennis and the art of conversation. He leaves behind his beloved mother, Lucille Brassfield, family and a host of friends. We will miss Ted's smile, passion and love for tennis.
